**TITLE: Oil Spill at Westridge Terminal, Burnaby , BC**

***Issued at: Tuesday, July 24, 2007 – 3:45 PM (PDT)***

**Burnaby, British Columbia.** Kinder Morgan Canada operator of the Westridge Marine Terminal facility in Burnaby, BC has been informed that one of its pipelines has been hit by a non-Kinder Morgan contractor working in the vicinity of the pipeline. No injuries have been reported.

All regulators have been notified, the site is being evacuated, and all steps are being taken to contain the spill at the earliest opportunity. Company emergency personnel are now on site to assess and contain the situation as well as local emergency responders. The Company is dedicating all resources, and outside assistance, to protect public safety and the environment.

An Emergency Command Centre has been set up, Fire personnel are on site, and Environment officials are en route.

Further updates will be released as information becomes available.

### **Details known at this time:**

- Product spilled/leaked:** Crude oil
- Estimate of spill size:** unknown at this time
- Notifications:** area residents and appropriate regulators

**Area currently being evacuated**

- ❑ **Spill response action:** Public safety, protection of the environment, spill containment and recovery and the safety of the response personnel are top priorities. The following measures have been taken:
- ❑ **Public Safety: No Public access to the site.**
