TITLE: Oil Spill Near Westridge Terminal, Burnaby , BC

Update at: Thursday, July 26, 2007 – 10:45 AM (PDT)

Burnaby, British Columbia. Clean up, environmental remediation and infrastructure repairs are ongoing after a third-party contractor damaged Kinder Morgan Canada's pipeline in Burnaby on July 24. Kinder Morgan Canada is working closely with the City of Burnaby, Focus Wildlife, Burrard Clean, and government agencies. Crews worked through the night, and oil recovery continues.

After 2 days, progress is as follows:

- Booming has contained oil in the marine area.
- Shoreline monitoring and clean-up is ongoing.
- Soil is being removed, and vacuum trucks continue to recover oil from storm drains.
- No new affected wildlife has been identified, and monitoring continues.
- Barnet Highway was partially opened to traffic at 6:00 am this morning.

A full environmental assessment is being conducted, and Kinder Morgan Canada is working directly with local area residents to ensure their needs and concerns are met. Information is being shared with appropriate agencies.
