Re: Notice of 2026 Cruise Fees

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority has approved the following cruise fees, which will take effect on January 1, 2026. The rates remain unchanged from 2025.

1. **Passenger Fees:** (unchanged from 2025)
 - a) Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday: \$20.10 per passenger.
 - b) Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday: \$19.31 per passenger.
2. **Services and Facilities Fees:** (unchanged from 2025)
 - a) Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday: \$44.15 x length of vessel (in metres) for the first 12-hour period or portion thereof.
 - b) Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday: \$42.26 x length of vessel (in metres) for the first 12-hour period or portion thereof.
3. **Cruise Terminal Fresh Water Supply Fee:** (unchanged from 2025)
\$2.43 per tonne.
