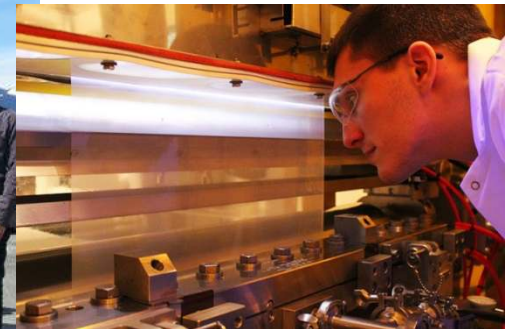

Proposed Development: Overview

- **Saltworks is expanding operations** – to meet Canadian and international demand
- **Project Permit application submitted to Port Metro Vancouver** – to build new desalination testing facility
- **Direct access to seawater required** – for testing & commissioning our systems before shipping to customers
- **Seawater used is recombined with freshwater produced** – returned to the ocean without any change in composition
- **Environmental protection & mitigation measures** – bio-swale, plant local vegetation, no trees removed



Proposed Development: Use

- **Use:** light assembly, staging, and testing of desalination equipment
 - Mechanical work will be performed inside the proposed building
 - Yard used for storage of new white shipping containers and fiberglass modules
- **Low impact:** no pollution, excessive noise, emissions, dust, or light
 - Minimal truck / delivery volume
 - Business hours only (Monday to Friday – 8am to 5:30pm)



Proposed Development: Site & Timeline

- **Site & Buildings:** 2205 Commissioner Street (former Cannery restaurant site)
 - Steel warehouse building with connected office: 18,500 sq ft – 35' high
 - Low profile white storage tents: 6500 sq ft (36' wide, 180' long) – 17' high
 - Surrounded by gated chain link fence
- **Timeline:**
 - Construction (pending permit approval) – 2015 Feb-June
 - Facility operational – 2015 July/August
