

Field Studies Information Sheet – September 2015

Port Metro Vancouver is continuing field studies in September 2015 as part of ongoing environmental and technical work for potential habitat enhancement sites. Monthly Field Studies Information Sheets are available at www.portmetrovancover.com/habitatenhancement.

Port Metro Vancouver is undertaking field studies at New Brighton Park in coordination with the Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation to investigate suitability of the area for potential habitat enhancement. The following field study is currently scheduled at New Brighton Park for the month of September 2015.

Study Name	Summary
<p>New Brighton Park Groundwater Assessment</p>	<p><u>Timing:</u> Assessment will take place over two to three days in September.</p> <p><u>Purpose:</u> The purpose of this field work is to assess soil and groundwater conditions on the east side of New Brighton Park in Vancouver, to investigate suitability for potential habitat enhancement.</p> <p><u>Field Work Area:</u> The field work area will include the upland area on the east side of New Brighton Park in Vancouver.</p> <p><u>Methods:</u> The assessment will involve investigation of six to eight boreholes at depths ranging from three to six metres, utilizing track-mounted drilling equipment suitable for site conditions. One or two field staff will attend the site with the contractor, and soil and groundwater conditions will be logged. Intermittent noise common to this type of investigation is anticipated.</p>

Ongoing monitoring: Port Metro Vancouver will continue to monitor the environmental conditions at completed Habitat Enhancement Program sites to ensure their biophysical objectives are being met.
