Re: **Vancouver Fraser Port Authority PER No. 15-180 Amendment
G3 Terminal Vancouver LP – G3 Terminal Vancouver**

Reference is made to the December 6th, 2017 request made by Peter Kiewit Sons ULC (Kiewit) on behalf of G3 Terminal Vancouver Limited Partnership (G3) to amend Permit 15-180 Condition 46. The amendment request is to reduce the size of the exclusion zone for harbour seals from 150 m to 50 m from the pile driving location.

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA) has reviewed the request and supporting memorandum from Envirowest Consultants Inc. dated November 29th, 2017. By way of this letter, the permit is amended to revise Permit Condition 46 and include an additional condition as follows:

1. **Revised Condition 46:** "The Applicant shall monitor marine mammals (using an appropriately qualified environmental professional) during in-water pile driving. The Applicant shall halt work immediately if a cetacean or Steller sea lion enters an exclusion zone within 600 m of the terminal, or if a harbor seal enters an exclusion zone within 50 m from the pile location. Pile driving must not resume until the marine mammal has left the exclusion zone for at least 30 minutes."
2. **Additional Condition:** "The Applicant shall conduct the works as described in the approved Marine Mammal Monitoring Plan, including the protocols for halting and resuming pile driving if a marine mammal exhibits disturbance behaviours outside the applicable exclusion zone."

The environmental review decision and conclusions of PER No. 15-180 are not affected by this amendment. All other conditions approved under PER No.15-180 shall be strictly adhered to during the works.

In the event of any breach of any of the Conditions, or of any of the background information being determined by VFPA to be incorrect or misleading, then VFPA, acting at its sole discretion, may arbitrarily cancel this Project Permit.
