The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority’s Habitat Enhancement Program is conducting field studies in April 2018 as part of ongoing environmental and technical work for the proposed Maplewood Marine Restoration Project.

Geotechnical and environmental subsurface work – proposed Maplewood Marine Restoration Project site	<p><u>Timing:</u> Assessments are scheduled to start in early April and occur periodically throughout the month. Activities are anticipated to include daytime and nighttime work, as necessary, due to tidal restrictions.</p> <p><u>Purpose:</u> To collect sediment, soil, and groundwater samples at the proposed Maplewood Marine Restoration Project site.</p> <p><u>Field work area:</u> The marine and upland areas of the proposed Maplewood Marine Restoration Project site, located on the north shore of Burrard Inlet, approximately two kilometres east of the Ironworkers Memorial Bridge, in North Vancouver, B.C.</p> <p><u>Methods:</u> Crews plan to conduct geotechnical and environmental subsurface work in the marine and upland areas of this proposed project site, which will involve marine and land-based drilling activities to support the collection of sediment, soil, and groundwater samples. Crews will access the marine work locations by small vessel and barge at suitable tides to ensure safety and environmental protection.</p>
