Re: Notice of New Proposed Fee

In accordance with Section 51 of the *Canada Marine Act*, the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority ("VFPA") Board of Directors has approved the following proposed new fee, anticipated to take effect on March 14, 2019:

Tsawwassen Container Examination Facility ("TCEF") Fee:

Inspected Cargo \$25 per TEU

This proposed new fee would be payable by the owner of inspected cargo and its purpose is to enable the VFPA to recover a portion of its costs relating to the Tsawwassen Container Examination Facility.

The proposed new TCEF fee is anticipated to be collected by the operator of the examination facility and remitted to the VFPA.
