



# Traffic notice: South Shore Access Project

The port authority is upgrading port roads on the south shore of Burrard Inlet to improve traffic flow and reduce existing conflict between road users and the rail network.

## As part of this project we will:

- Build a new overpass on Centennial Road to remove road and rail conflicts
- Construct a new Vehicle Access Control System (VACS) gate under Main Street overpass
- Connect Waterfront Road to Centennial Road, creating a continuous port road from Canada Place to McGill Street
- Remove the Heatley Avenue overpass
- Coordinate with other tenant, port maintenance and road upgrades on port lands

## Traffic impacts:

- Periods of single lane alternating traffic along Centennial Road, Stewart Street, and Commissioner Street
- For periods of the project, non-emergency traffic will be unable to enter port lands from Clark Drive overpass and will reroute to enter port lands via the Commissioner Street entrance near New Brighton Park

## Hours of work:

- Monday to Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Starting early 2020, portions of construction on Centennial Road will take place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
