NEB Condition Compliance Letter No. 19 highlighted an inadvertent omission made in the Westridge Environmental Protection Plan (EPP) Rev 5, filed with the Board in March 2018. That omission has been corrected as per the direction of the Board, and Trans Mountain hereby files the Westridge Marine Terminal EPP Rev 6. The only change in the document from Rev 5 is addition of a sentence in Section 6 and updating of dates as set out in Table 1 below.
