# Delta is a port city



Every year, port activity in Delta supports:

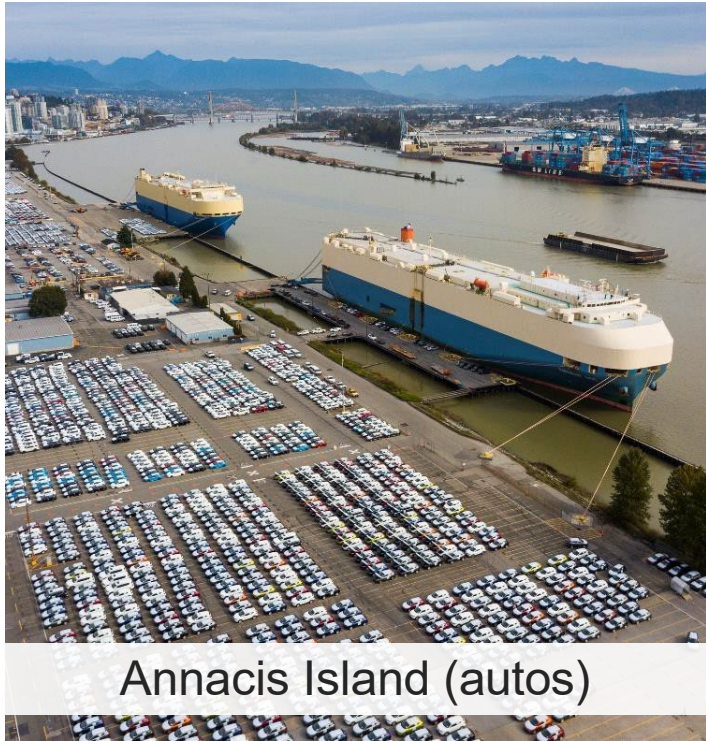
- 4,800 jobs
- \$300 million in wages
- \$1.06 billion in economic activity
- \$7.78 million municipal tax paid by port tenants
- \$938,000 paid in lieu of taxes for vacant port land

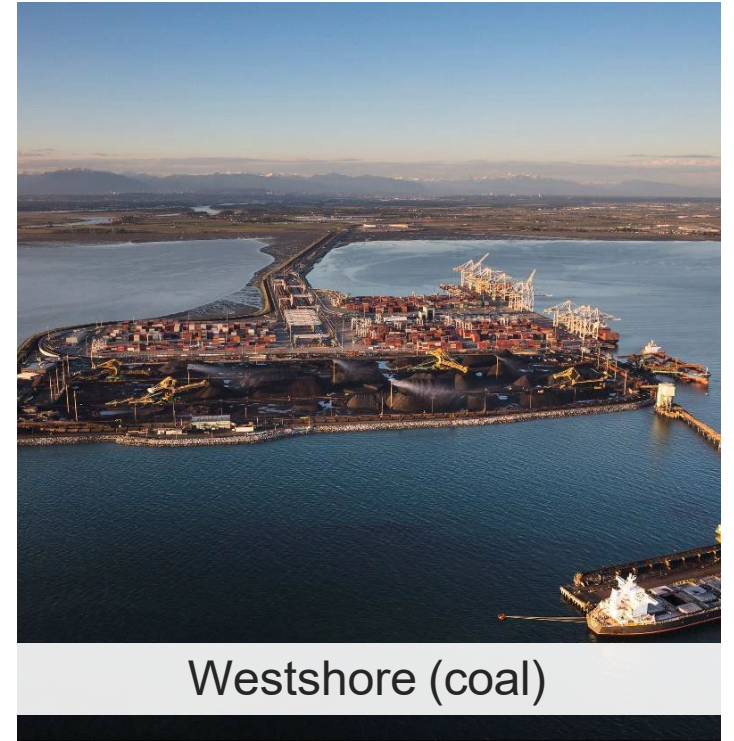

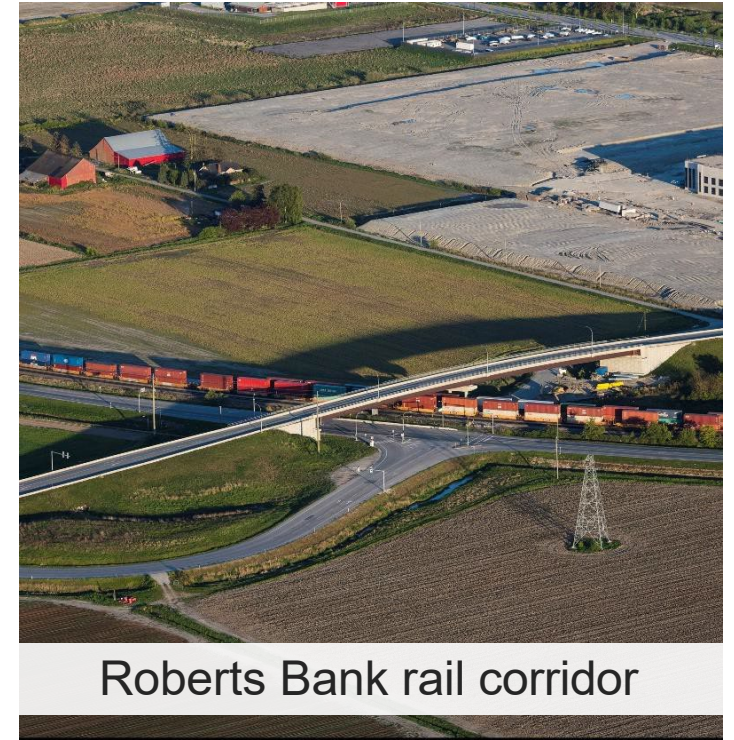

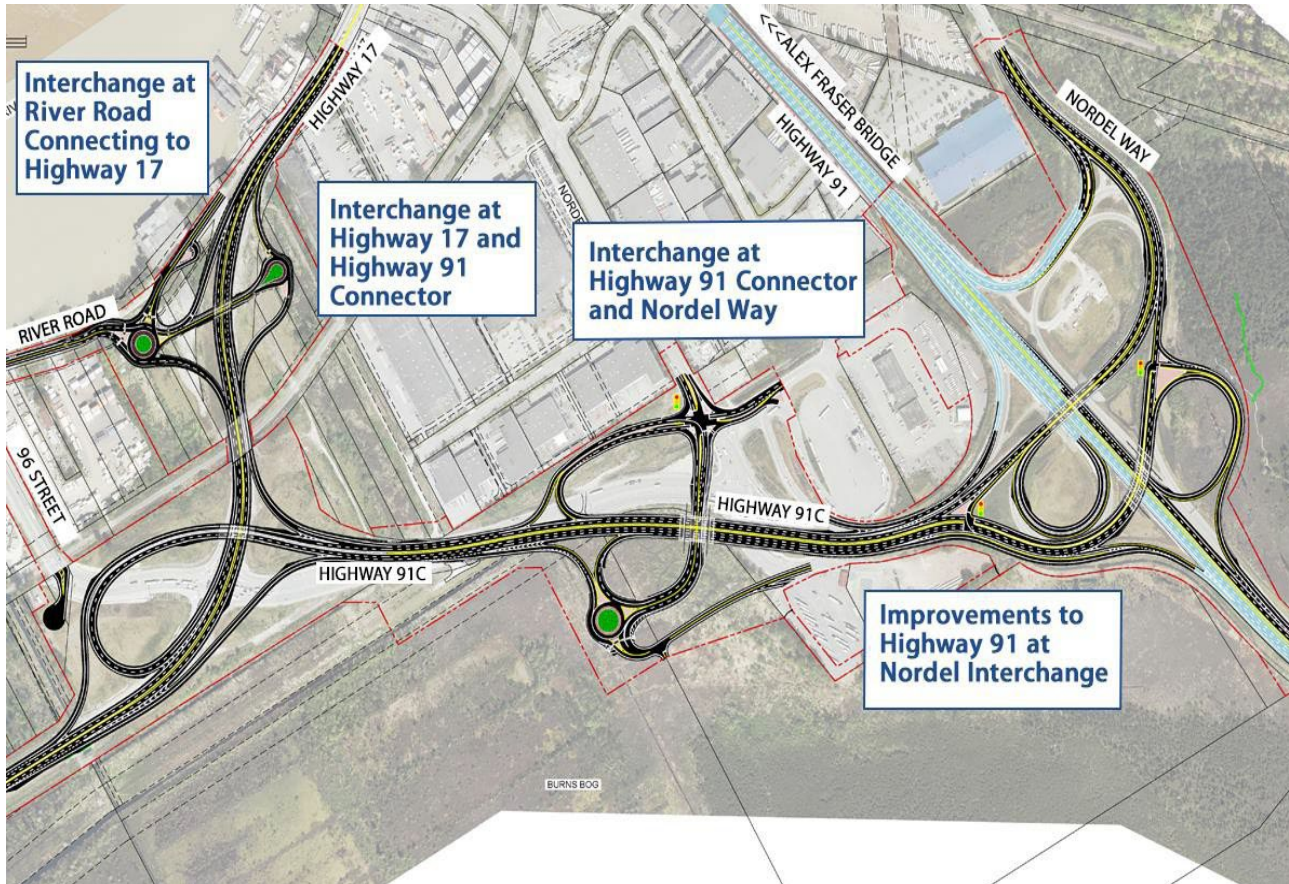

# Roberts Bank Terminal 2 community investment program

Providing **\$6 million** to support Delta organizations and students should the RBT2 project proceed, with an initial \$500,000 of the community fund made available following a positive decision from the federal government



## **\$2 million** in community grants

- Organizations that support the Delta community will be invited to submit grant proposals for a minimum of \$50,000, and will be selected based on a matrix of factors



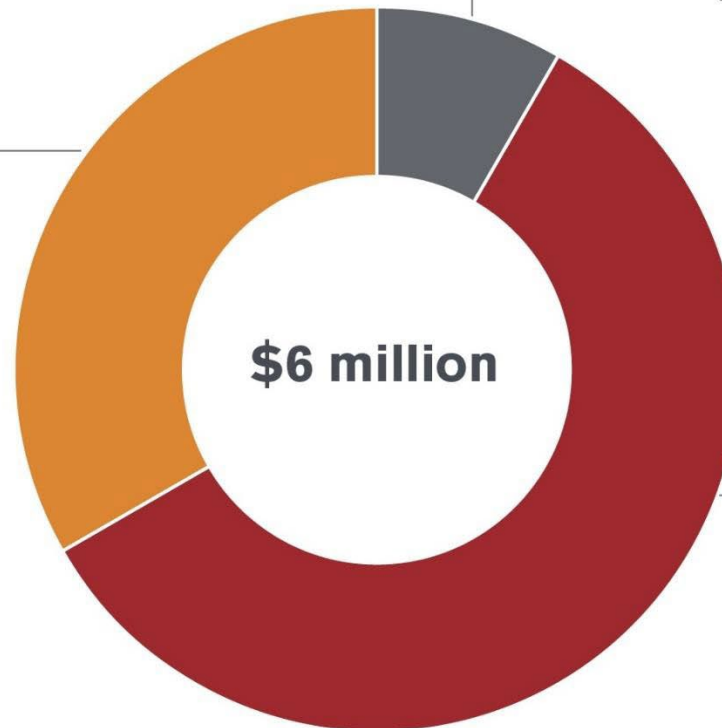
## **\$500,000** education fund

- Bursaries will be made available to grade 12 students at public schools in Delta who are pursuing post-secondary training or education



## **\$3.5 million** community fund

- Organizations that support the Delta community may apply for a maximum of \$50,000 per year, in line with the port authority's existing community investment program
