Re: Notice of 2024 Cruise Fee amendments

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority has approved the following cruise fee amendments that will take effect January 1, 2024:

- 1. Passenger Fees: 6.8% (2022 CPI) increase from 2023 Fees
 - a) Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday: increase by \$1.23 to \$19.34 per passenger
 - b) Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday: increase by \$1.18 to \$18.58 per passenger
- 2. Services and Facilities Fees: 6.8% (2022 CPI) increase from 2023 Fees
 - a) Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday: increase by \$2.71 to \$42.50 x length of vessel (in metres) and time at berth
 - b) Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday: increase by \$2.59 to \$40.67 x length of vessel (in metres) for the first 12-hour period or portion thereof
- 3. Cruise Terminal Fresh Water Supply Fee: 6.8% (2022 CPI) increase from 2023 Fees Cruise Terminal Fresh Water Supply Fee: increase by \$0.15 to a rate of \$2.34 per tonne
