Re: Notice of Proposed New Fee

In accordance with Section 51 of the *Canada Marine Act*, the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority board of directors has approved the following new fee that is proposed to take effect on August 18, 2021:

Truck Exception Application Fee:

Per application submitted \$1100 per vehicle (plus applicable taxes)

Each application by a Truck Licensing System participant for an exception from application of the Rolling Truck Age Program would be required to be accompanied by a non-refundable Truck Exception Application Fee.

The proposed new Truck Exception Application Fee will be charged in order to recover third party costs of initial inspection and reporting on applicant vehicles and to recover port authority costs associated with implementation and management of the exception application process. Costs associated with more extensive inspection, if required, are not intended to be captured under this fee.
