AREA OF WORK

General construction work will take place between Columbia Containers and Western Canada Marine Response Corporation. Low impact construction work during the night and high impact construction work during the day will take place at Manhole S1 (see below) near Columbia Containers central gate and at Western Canada Marine Response Corporation.
