

COMMISSIONER STREET ROAD AND RAIL REALIGNMENT PROJECT

EXTENDED WORK HOURS SCHEDULE (JUNE 28 TO AUGUST 31, 2021)

Between June 28 and August 31, 2021, construction activities will continue during port authority standard work hours (Monday to Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.). AREA OF WORK

General construction work will take place between Nanaimo Street and New Brighton Road. Low impact construction work during the night and high impact construction work during the day will take place between Manhole S1 (see below) near Columbia Containers central gate and New Brighton Road.
