

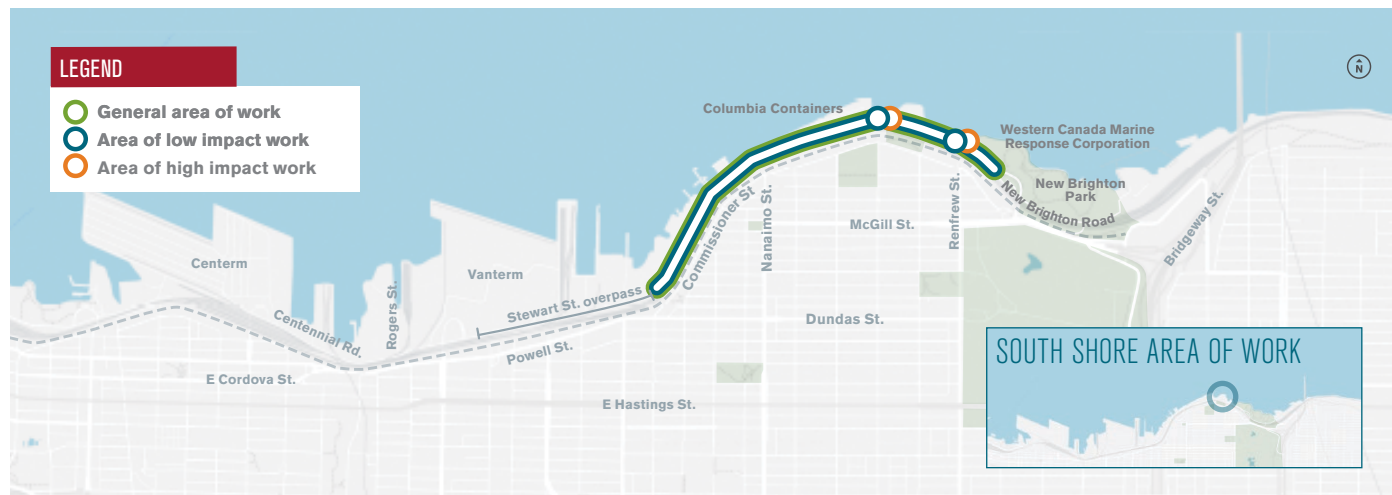
Commissioner Street Road and Rail Realignment Project

























Extended Work Hours Schedule (June 29 to July 31, 2022)

Between June 29 and July 31, 2022, construction activities related to the bypass pumping and subsequent finishing road works and lane painting will commence during port authority standard work hours (Monday to Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.) along a portion of Commissioner Street. In addition, some works will take place outside of port authority standard work hours, as shown in the schedule below. Pending weather conditions, the dates outlined below may change.
