Project overview

Vancouver Fraser Port Authority – Commissioner Street Road and Rail Realignment Project

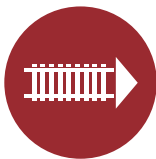
We led the following road improvements:



- Removal of the old Columbia Containers grain elevator (*completed in early 2020*)
- Construction of a retaining wall (*completed in 2021*)
- Changes to Commissioner Street near Columbia Containers, includes shifting the road north, paving and adding a new lane (*completed in 2022*)
- Relocation of the impacted utilities including Metro Vancouver's Harbour East Interceptor (*completed in 2022*)

Canadian Pacific (CP) Rail Expansion Project

CP is leading the following rail improvements:



- Installation of additional rail tracks next to current tracks, from four tracks to six tracks
- This project received a separate project and environmental review permit.

Construction started in late 2022 and is expected to be completed in late 2023

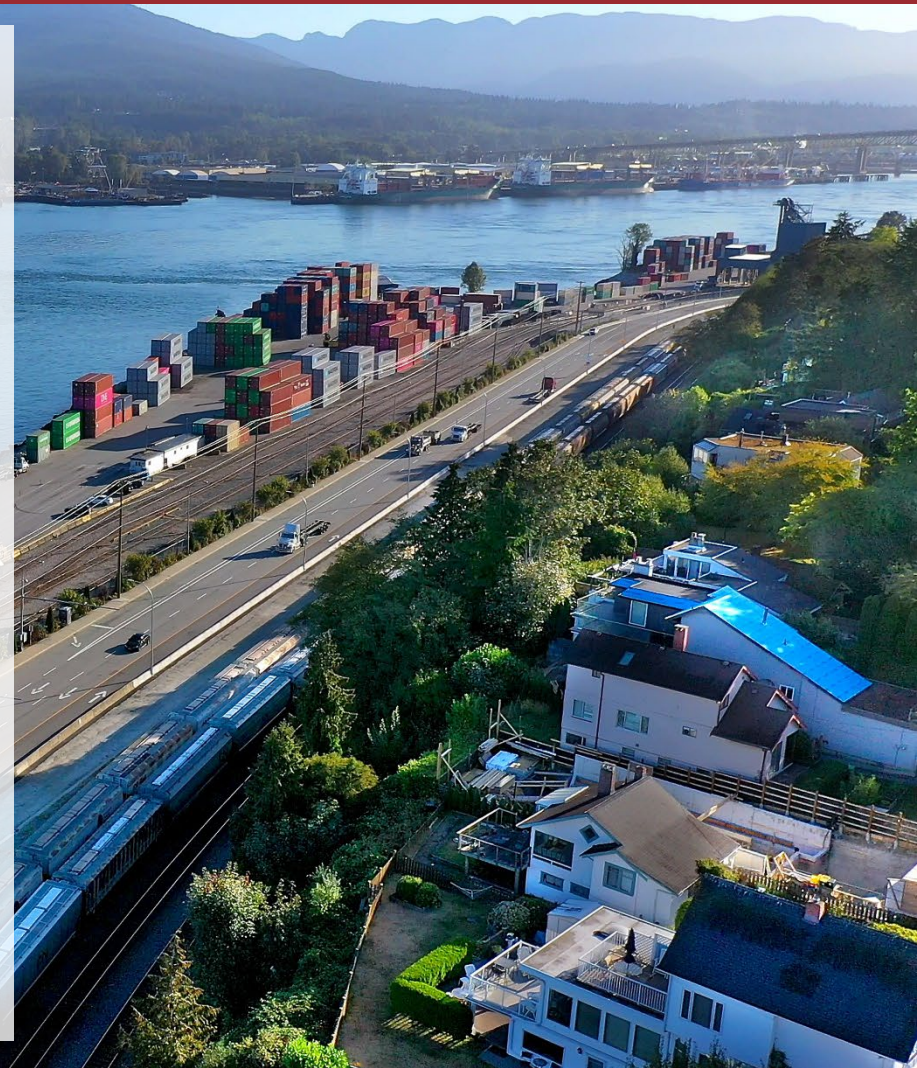
Project locations

Commissioner Street Road and Rail Improvements

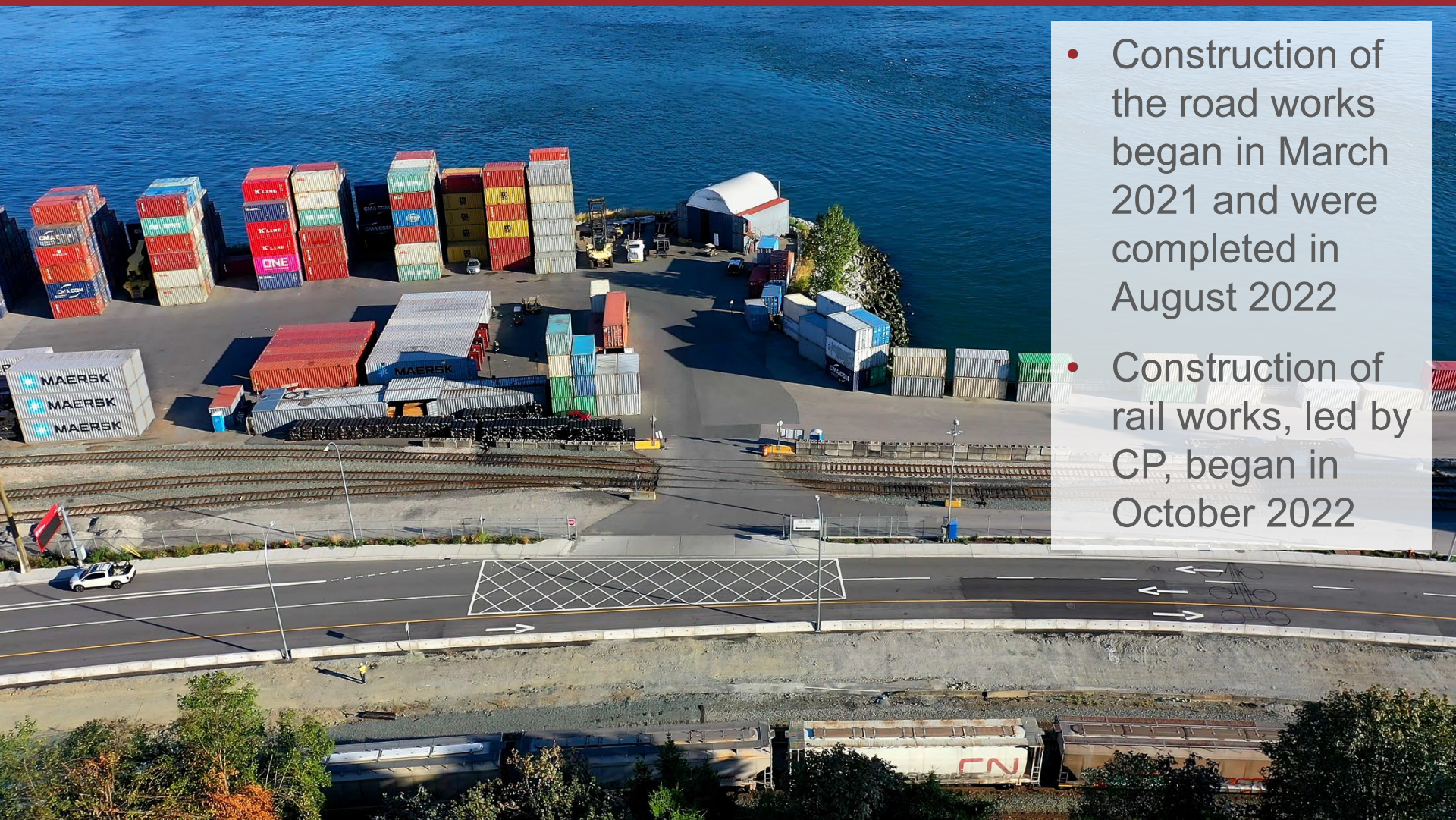


Project benefits

- Improves movement, flow and access to terminal facilities for commercial traffic
- Enables safe and efficient access to port terminal workers, port authority employees, first responders, and service providers
- Supports trade growth and increases local and national jobs, by providing land for rail track expansion
- Expands rail capacity by reconfiguring existing tracks and providing new track sidings



Project status



- Construction of the road works began in March 2021 and were completed in August 2022
- Construction of rail works, led by CP, began in October 2022
