Re: Rolling Truck Age Program will not move forward on April 3

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority is committed to implementing the most effective programs to support its vision of making the Port of Vancouver the world's most sustainable port.

In light of the current economic landscape and continued pandemic-related issues, we will again defer implementation of the Rolling Truck Age Program for no less than nine months.

In the interim, we will be considering new technologies, as well as federal and provincial fleet greening programs, as we reassess our emissions reduction strategy to ensure we progress in a manner that will best achieve the objectives of our Truck Licensing System. The port authority will continue to consult with the drayage sector, port community, government, and local and Indigenous communities to refine the approach moving forward.

The investment in newer, cleaner technology by the majority of truck operators servicing the Port of Vancouver has not gone unnoticed. Future programs to support the phasing out of truck-related emissions at the Port of Vancouver will recognize these efforts.
