#### Introduction:

CIPA Lumber Co. Ltd. (CIPA) operates a wood processing facility that specializes in the production of softwood veneer; the facility is generally located at 797 Carlisle Road in Delta, British Columbia. Maintenance dredging is required on a regular basis (e.g., typically multiple times per year) to remove substrates in order to restore design depths for the safe navigation of vessels / equipment during all tidal conditions. CIPA has received a project permit (PER No. 23-042) from the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority for maintenance dredging works.

### **Summary of Works:**

Fraser River Pile & Dredge (GP) Inc. will be conducting the works on behalf of CIPA. The works will be carried out from the water (i.e., with a crane situated on a spud derrick); therefore, disruptions to traffic flow in the area are not expected. Noise and/or lighting disruptions are not expected to be beyond those associated with the day-to-day operations of facility. The crane, equipped with a clamshell bucket, will be utilized to load dredgeate onto a flat scow for transport to the disposal site. The proposed works have been approved by the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority and Environment and Climate Change Canada.

### **Maintenance Dredging Schedule:**

Works are expected to commence on, or shortly after, July 06, 2023 and be completed within approximately 4-days (i.e., tentative schedule of July 06 - 09). Dredging is expected to be conducted between the hours of 0700 - 1900 and will include Saturday and Sunday.
