Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA) Notice of Fee Amendments: Gateway Infrastructure Fee 2 (GIF2)

In accordance with Section 51 of the *Canada Marine Act*, the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (port authority) Board of Directors has approved the following proposed fee amendments that will take effect on the dates noted below.

GIF2 is intended to recover 90% of the port authority's investments and costs associated with the Gateway Infrastructure Program. GIF2 is payable in respect of laden containers, by the owner of the vessel and in respect of non-containerized cargo, by the owner of cargo.

The following GIF2 amendments will take effect on January 1, 2024:
